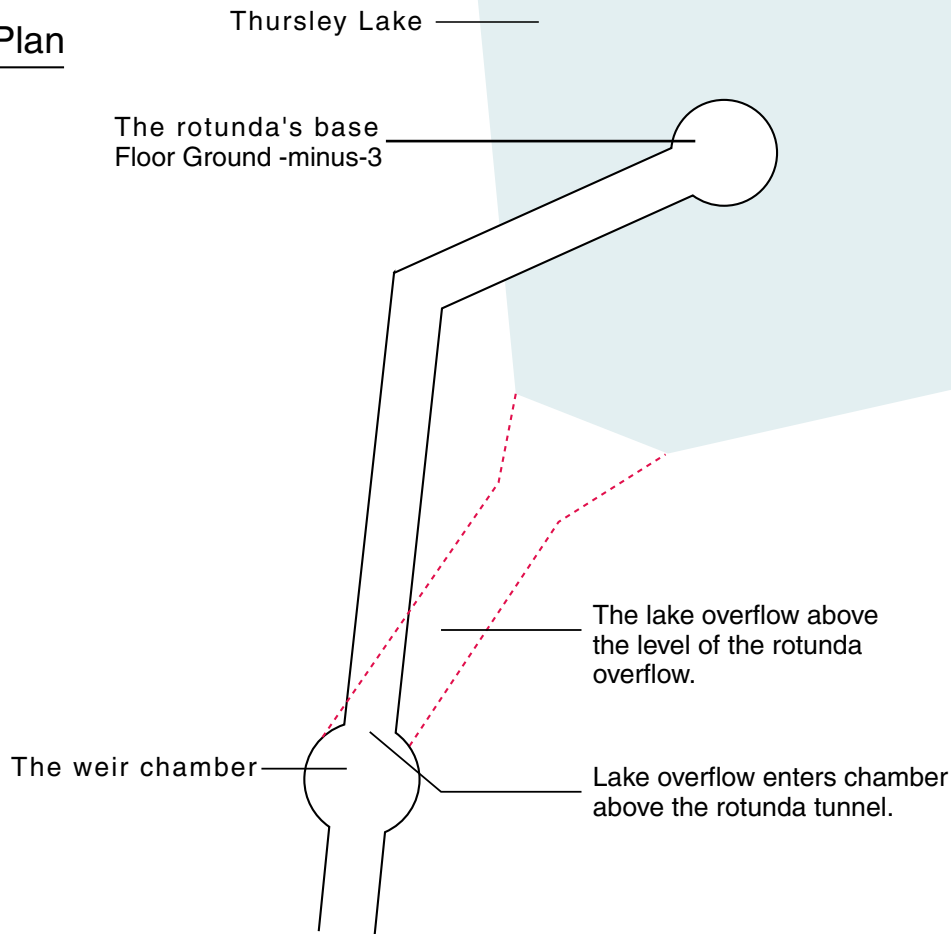


Underground Ice House,
Witley Park

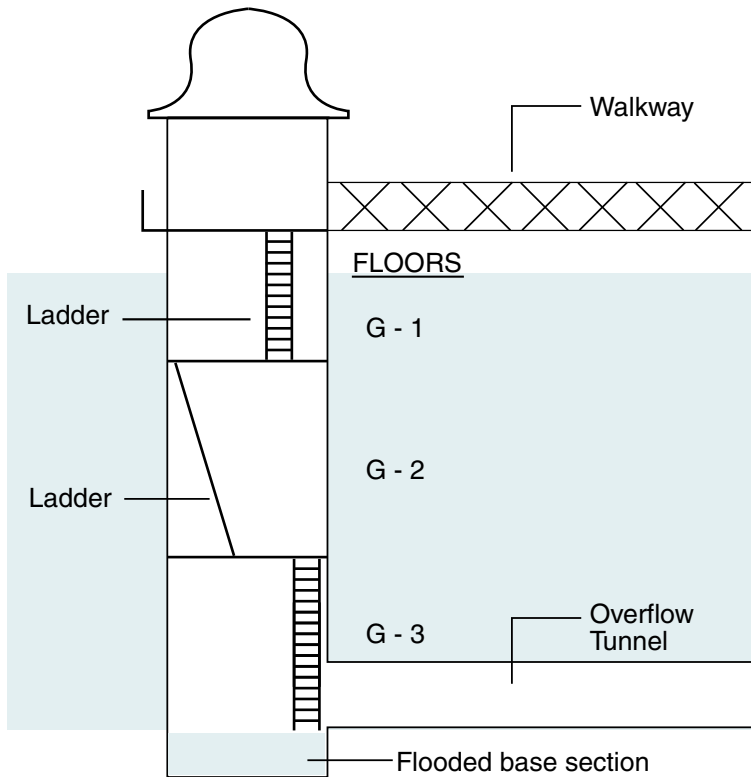
Notes: Room #1 is a circular room with a glazed ceiling at ground level & glass fillet floor covers to allow light to travel down to Room #3. Room #2 is a semi-circular room with alcoves, & a sunken floor which is flooded. Room #3 is a cavernous space with a waterway at its far end which leads out onto the lake.

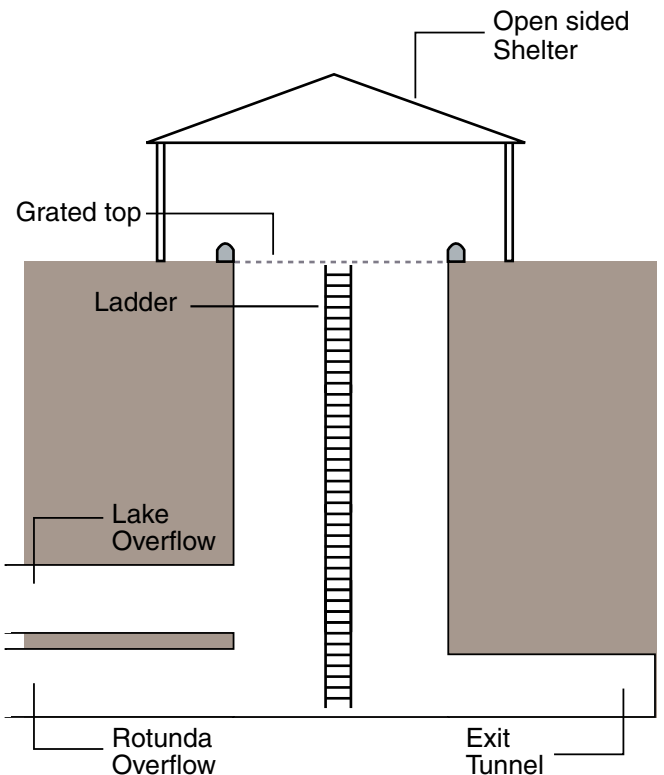
Overview Plan

Notes: The rotunda's floors are of an iron grill construction allowing some light to travel down from above. At floor G-minus-1 there is a diesel engine of some description. The overflow/weir chamber is of brick construction as are the two overflow tunnels. No water flows through the rotunda overflow.
